RULING OF MARCH 3, 2015

On February 15, 2015, Dr. Padmanabhan filed Motion to Request Issuance of a Written Ruling Regarding Respondent's Raising of the Doctrine of Unclean Hands. It referred to an unnamed motion filed in "early January 2015." On February 23, 2015, in a handwritten endorsement, I wrote,

The respondent's vagueness about the name and date of his motion make it hard to check the docket. Nonetheless, I do not believe that the motion came before me. The respondent will file another copy without commentary.

Instead of submitting another copy, Dr. Padmanaban filed a motion dated March 2, 2015. In his cover letter, he referred to it as a "resubmission with clarified title."

If the motion from early January 2015 is before me, I deny it. If I have already ruled on it orally, I deny the motion to rule on it in writing. I deny Dr. Padmanabhan's motion dated March 2, 2015.

I repeat what I have said at least once before: I expect Dr. Padmanabhan to be familiar with what I can and cannot do as an administrative magistrate. His motions that I take actions that I am not authorized to do require an unnecessary expenditure of administrative resources.
