**ORDER OF MARCH 2, 2016**

I received the Board of Registration in Medicine's remand order and Dr. Padmanabhan's responses to it.<sup>1</sup> I am working on a recommended decision responding to the remand order and have expedited my writing of it, cognizant of Dr. Padmanabhan's motion reporting that an expedited decision could help him earn a living.

In further response to Dr. Padmanabhan's submissions, I note two things before issuing a revised recommended decision. The remand order does not order me to alter my decision, which is Dr. Padmanabhan's concern. It does order me to clarify and explain some parts of my recommended decision. I will clarify and explain and, if necessary, reconsider parts of my decision. I will not be wedded to my previous recommended decision. Nor do I consider myself under an order to alter its substance to meet BRM's expectations of what I should have recommended.


Dr. Padmanabhan's emergency motion dated February 22, 2016 asks that I find that my
